We Offer Pupils:

- Specialist diagnosis of literacy and processing difficulties including dyslexia.
- Strategies for learning difficulties communicated to all teaching staff.
- Bespoke teaching strategies adopted by teachers where needed.
- Booster groups for Prep pupils where appropriate.
- 1:1 learning support lessons where appropriate.
- The opportunity to complete a 'one page profile' to enable teachers to understand your strengths and challenges.
- Daily 'drop-in' sessions where you can talk to a member of Learning Support staff.
- Opportunities to take internal assessments in the Learning Support teaching rooms if this is felt necessary for your individual needs.
- Emotional support to help you through any difficult times you may have.
- Specialist assessments to address your needs and provide provision for your GCSE examinations.
- Opportunities through assemblies to recognise different types of learning difficulties and to celebrate these differences.
- The opportunity to be assessed to use a laptop in the senior school to help with your organisation and writing tasks.

We Offer Parents:

- A friendly, open-door policy where you are invited to telephone or see us at any time.
- Formal meeting times where we can talk to you about specific issues.
- Weekly parent 'drop-in' sessions where we are available to talk to you about any issues, or just to have a chat!
- Knowledge that your child will be challenged in a supportive environment where their needs will be assessed and catered for.
- Individual Education Plans for all pupils having 1:1 learning support lessons.
- Peace of mind that your child's individual needs are recognised and support put in place to address these.
- Parent workshops.
- Knowledge that your child's progress is closely monitored and interventions and strategies adopted to boost this performance if necessary.
- Support and assistance when seeking advice from external professional agencies (for example psychologists, speech and language therapists, occupational therapists etc).
